Scholarship information:

*Students must be accepted into a North Dakota college or university and plan to be an instrumental (band) music education major.

*Students must furnish an official transcript (preferably from the fall semester of their senior year).

*Students must write an essay describing their musical background and band experiences. The essay should include details of what being in band has meant to the student. Essays should be a minimum of one full page.

*The scholarship is a onetime cash award of \$1,000.00. The actual check will be awarded at the end of the student's first semester of college. Students will also need to show proof of registration as an instrumental (band) music major for their second semester of college.

*The recipient will be presented with a Scholarship Certificate at the NDMEA All-State Concert held in March at the Bismarck Events Center.

*The scholarship will be based on the decision of the committee. Committee members will be informed by the music stores with the order being alphabetically.

*There will be no input from anyone associated with any of North Dakota's colleges or universities.
